**THEN . . .** back to school on Wednesday, August 23!!

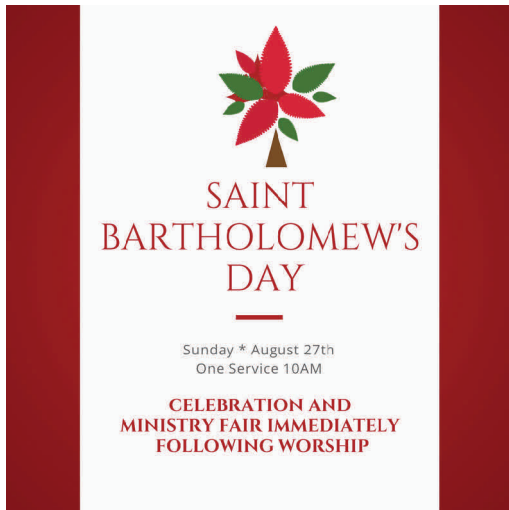

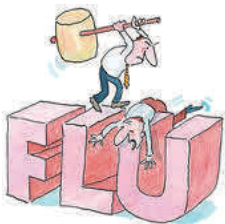
