Okay, St. Squirmy just might not be a real saint, at least not yet! He was canonized at St. John's Episcopal Church in Charlotte, N.C. in January, A.D. 2016!

When you enter the Narthex off to the left, you will find a area with books, children's bibles and coloring sheets available for our young members.

To The Parents of Young Children May We Suggest...

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome! Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going at the Altar. They tire of seeing the back of other's heads.

Explain quietly the parts of the liturgy and actions the priest, lay servers, choir, band etc. Sing the hymns or songs, pray and voice the responses. children learn liturgical behaviors by copying you. If you have to leave the service with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me." Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.
